Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performed failure analysis on customer returns from various product lines resulting in ECOs aimed at fixing design deficiencies
- Managed component obsolescence issues in various products, with some of the tasks involved including identifying alternate parts and verifying them in current designs or redesigning boards to accept the alternates.
- Using six sigma tools, was able to improve quality on products suffering low yield issues in production. I gathered data from various products on failure modes at different production steps and analyzed it and came up with solutions based on this that resulted in a better manufactured product with high yield.
- Interfaced with manufacturing engineers in transitioning products from the development group to manufacturing. This involved writing build and test procedures, overseeing pilot run alongside the manufacturing engineers and initial support during first production lot.
